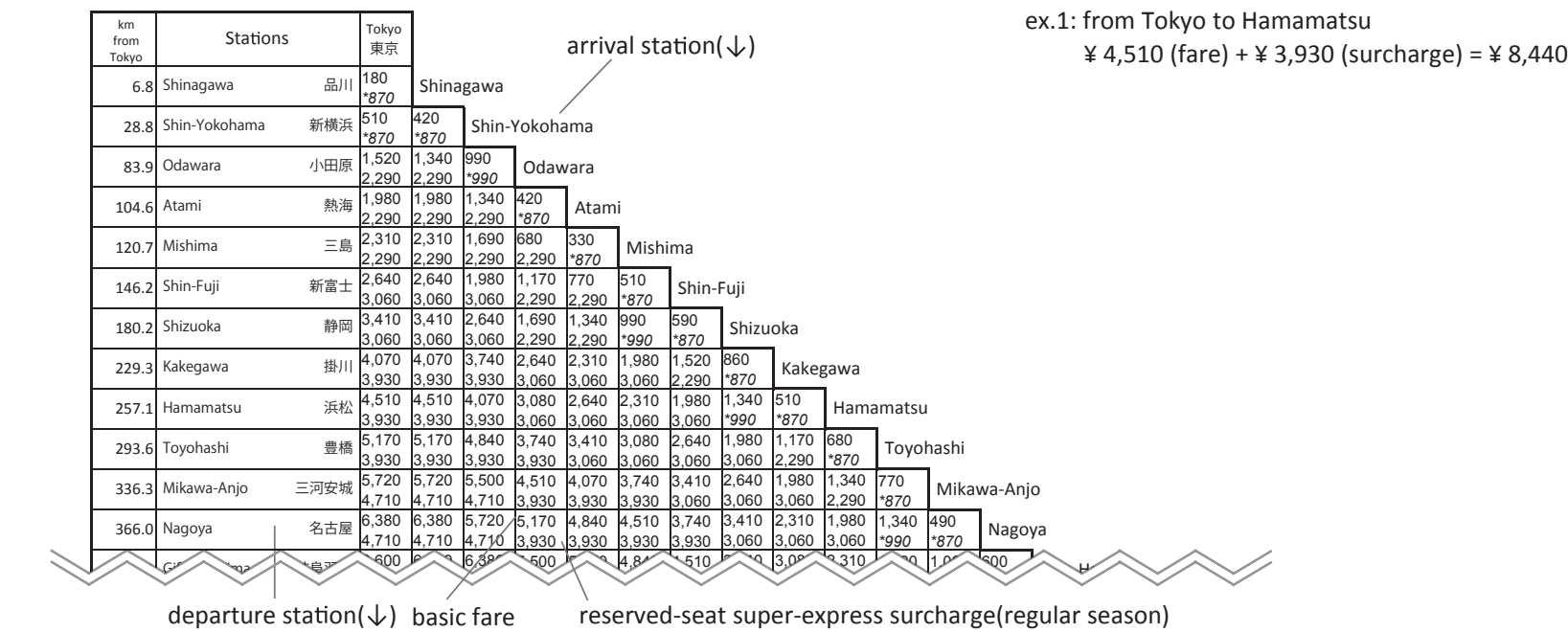


How to use the Fares and Surcharges Table

First, look for “your” departure station on the vertical axis, and also your arrival station on the horizontal axis; then trace from both stations, one across, and the other down the table; where the two stations meet, you will find the cost of your journey in the corresponding box. Basic fare is written above, and the reserved-seat super-express surcharge (regular season) is indicated below. The sum is your actual cost.

- Notes: 1. Different rules apply for the NOZOMI and MIZUHO trains. Charges are indicated in the table as follows: the basic fare in the top row; the reserved-seat super-express surcharge (regular season) in the middle row; and the super-express surcharge applied when a non-reserved seat is taken (the charges written in italics in the table are the special express surcharge) in the bottom row.
